We are happy to welcome Cyber Freight International as our 'launching customer' of eCargo Pouch. On April 28th, Cyber Freight International submitted its first E-Freight shipment from AMS (Amsterdam Schiphol) to TPE (Taipei-Chiang Kai Shek) supported by eCargo Pouch. During the coming weeks, Cyber Freight and counterpart World Int'l Corp. (WIC) will upscale the number of shipments and trade lanes.

As Jacques van den Berg, Director of Cyber Freight Amsterdam B.V. says: "E-freight shipping is a typical Cyber Freight way of shipping."

"The introduction of the E-waybill is about time. It has always been Cyber Freight's goal to use the maximum possible in electronic features. The entire Cyber Freight Team at Schiphol is excited and find it challenging to continue to work and develop the E-air waybill in joint cooperation with our Cargo Community Service provider Cargonaut. To the Cyber Freight team, as they mention it: "E-Freight will soon be the new way of handling air cargo in the 21st century and it will be a priority for Cyber Freight to be one of the pioneers in Western Europe to handle all cargo by E-freight procedures using electronic equipment.

Besides the excitement, our teams are trying to take priority in saving our environment and this E-freight option is an excellent start. The "old" air waybill had at least 14 pages of paper and old fashion printers like matrix printers were a 'must' to handle this thick pouch of paperwork. Therefore, we kick off on less paper pollution straight away, and the days of the high produced noise from the matrix printers are history.

Within the global network named L.I.N.K., it was easy to find partners who wished to join us in this new project of paperless air waybills. Taiwan, WIC, is offering full support to develop this new feature between Amsterdam and Taipei and later on into mainland China."

"This is feeling 'Cyberish'; this new development will suit into the Cyber Freight organisation very well!", says Martijn Brugman from the export department.

As Van den Berg continues: "Together with eCargo Pouch we will commit ourselves to pave the way into the new era of computer highways and we will keep you informed via our website: www.cyberfreight.nl."
